Dr. Teresa H. Meng is the recipient of the prestigious 2024 Marconi Prize in recognition of her fundamental technical contributions to and commercial leadership in all-CMOS Wi-Fi technology, leading to its widespread use in practice.

Meng's groundbreaking research, engineering, and entrepreneurial vision have made Wi-Fi technology faster, more energyefficient, and cost-effective so that it can be a critical part of everyday life.

Guglielmo Marconi 150th Birthday Celebration

Guglielmo Marconi was born in Bologna, Italy, on April 25, 1874. An inquisitive scientist and researcher, at the age of 35 Marconi would earn the 1909 Nobel Prize in Physics (shared with Karl Ferdin and Braun), for his contributions to wireless telegraphy.

He experimented with the application of Hertzian waves to the wireless transmission of messages over a long distance. He successfully transmitted a signal across a distance of 2km through the obstacle of a hill and continued his experiments until he was able to successfully transmit a message 2,100 miles across the Atlantic Ocean in 1901.

Marconi passed away in 1937 at the age of 63. He was laid to rest at the Villa Griffone, the Marconi family residence, which is now celebrated as the birthplace of wireless. 2024 marks his 150th Birthday Celebration.

The Marconi Society **Celebrating 50 Years**

Guglielmo Marconi's daughter, Gioia Marconi Braga, founded the Guglielmo Marconi International Fellowship Foundation (now the Marconi Society) in 1974. Since its founding, the Marconi Society has continued to celebrate the leading innovators in advanced communications while expanding its role as a primary advocate for research, partnerships, and programming in service of digital inclusion. 2024 marks the 50th Anniversary of the Marconi Society.

The Marconi Prize

The Marconi Fellows are some of the most respected engineers in the world. Many work actively to bring the opportunities of connectivity to everyone. They have changed our lives by creating an Internet that is available, accessible, secure, and useful and putting its power into the hands of billions of people.
